MEETING

The Manchester Township Board of Supervisors held a scheduled and duly advertised meeting on Monday, March 22, 2021, which was called to order at 1:30 p.m. by Chairperson Wingert. BUSINESS

Ordinance #2021-02 - Concord Public Finance - Refinance

Attorney Laura Kurtz of Eckert Seamans provided a report of a public advertisement mistake relative to the March 9, 2021 Board of Supervisors action to adopt an ordinance to authorize the financing for Series 2021 (\$3,243,000) and Series 2021A (\$2,561,300) as summarized in item #5 of the March 9, 2021 manager's report. Attorney Kurtz reported the requirement to consider the readoption of Ordinance #2021-02 now that the required advertising in York Newspapers has been satisfied. Ms. McCune made a motion, seconded by Mr. Inch, adopt Ordinance #2021-02 authorizing the issuance of general obligation debt totaling \$5,804,300 (inclusive of refinancing Series 2015 General Obligation Bond).

Motion carried. Ayes-5 Nays-0.
