# **Ever wonder what you need to do to close your street and have a neighborhood block party?**

During the summer and early fall the office staff often receives calls asking this very question.

The Board of Supervisors must authorize any closures of township streets (this does not include state roadways).

Your request should be submitted in writing, in a timely fashion, to the attention of the township manager.

Please include the following in your request:

- 1. The date and time of the block party & whether there is a rain date.
- 2. A drawing showing the exact location and whether there is an alternate route which can be used by motorists while the road is closed.
- 3. The signatures of all property owners adjacent to the section of the affected roadway which you would like to close indicating they have no objection.

If these easy steps are followed, the Board will most likely grant your request. Upon granting such a request, the Board directs that the township public works department drop off barricades which can be used to close the roadway during your block party. The township does request you keep all tables and chairs to one side, so in the event that there would be an emergency situation an ambulance, fire truck or police car, could easily gain access to the area by using the side of the roadway where there are no obstacles.

### **Sewer Backup Claims**

Under the Pennsylvania Governmental Immunity Statute, Manchester Township has limited legal responsibility for sewer and water backups. You should contact your homeowners or commercial insurance agent to make sure you carry coverage for sewer and water backups under your homeowner's or commercial property policy. Some homeowners policies do not include this coverage automatically. We recommend that you purchase this valuable coverage.

### **Tips from your Tax Collector**

School real estate bills for the '09-'10 tax cycle will be mailed on July 15th. These bills are for the period July 1st, 2009 thru June 30th, 2010. If you do not receive your bill, please contact the tax office.

Once again, Central York School District will be offering a three-installment payment plan. To participate, you must pay the first installment by August 15th, 2009. Please note: The three installments add up to the FACE amount of the bill – meaning you forfeit the 2% discount. To get the discount, the full rebate amount must be paid by September 15th, 2009. Remember to include both halves of your bill if you need a receipt for tax or rebate purposes.

### **Smoke Testing Sewer Lines**

Manchester Township Public Works Department periodically conducts smoke tests of the sanitary sewer lines. Testing is conducted Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

### Notice

Smoke should not enter premises unless a leak is present. This smoke is non-toxic, non-corrosive, and will not leave a stain. If smoke enters a home, it will soon dissipate. Opening doors and windows will help. Any presence of smoke within the house should be reported to the township office at 764-4646. Avoid unnecessary exposure to the smoke. The smoke is relatively harmless, but all smoke is temporary and quickly disappears after exposure has ceased.

### **A Note From The Pa Dept Of Revenue:**

New Web Tool Allows Pennsylvanians to Check Status of Property Tax/Rent Rebates Eligible older adults and residents with disabilities can now check the status of Property Tax/Rent Rebate applications online at www.papropertytaxrelief.com.

"Our commitment to property tax relief is unwavering, and this new Web tool enhances customer service for the older adults and people with disabilities who rely on these annual checks," Governor Edward G. Rendell said, introducing the new tool in late April.

Six weeks after submitting a Property Tax/Rent Rebate application, the applicant may visit www. papropertytaxrelief.com and check the status of the rebate by entering his/her Social Security number, anticipated rebate amount and birth date. Applicants may use the Web site to confirm claim status, rebate amount and the date a rebate is expected to be mailed or direct-deposited. Rebate checks will begin being distributed to early applicants on July 1.

Through a similar automated phone service, Property Tax/Rent Rebate applicants can check rebate status by calling, toll-free, 1-888-PATAXES.

The new online tool to check rebate status has the potential to reduce administrative costs for the Revenue Department. The online service is maintained at a minimal cost, while each toll-free phone call from taxpayers costs the department about 3.1 cents in phone charges, plus costs associated with staffing.

The rebate program benefits eligible Pennsylvanians age 65 and older; widows and widowers age 50 and older; and people with disabilities age 18 and older. A 2006 program expansion increased the income limit from \$15,000 to \$35,000 (which excludes half of Social Security income) for homeowners and raises the maximum standard rebate for both homeowners and renters from \$500 to \$650. The income limit for renters is \$15,000.

The program expansion also provided for supplemental property tax rebates of up to \$325 – on top of the standard rebates – to homeowners in Philadelphia, Pittsburgh and Scranton and to those in other parts of the state who pay more than 15 percent of income on property taxes.

Property Tax/Rent Rebate claim forms (PA-1000) and information are available online at www. papropertytaxrelief.com and by calling 1-888-222-9190. Forms and assistance also are available at Department of Revenue district offices (listed in the government section of local telephone directories), local Area Agencies on Aging, senior centers and state legislators' offices.

The deadline to apply for a rebate on property taxes or rent paid in 2008 is Dec. 31.
