within Manchester Township recreational facilities, is **PROHIBITED**. term "motorized vehicles" shall include, but not be limited to, licensed motor vehicles as defined by the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, trail bikes or dirt bikes, all-terrain vehicles (three or four wheeled,) snowmobiles, golf carts and hoverboards.



### **May in Motion FAQ's**

#### Q. How do I sign up?

A. Go to https://bit.ly/3sWFh1M to register.

#### Q. Is there a fee to register?

A. Nope! This activity is FREE!

#### Q. When is registration?

A. You can register now until the end of May.

### Q. Do I have to register each person in my family?

A. Yes, each person participating needs to be registered.

#### Q. It's after May 1st, can I still register?

A. Yes, you can register up until the end. Every minute helps your municipality.

### Q. My child doesn't have email. What do I enter on the registration form?

A. Use the parent/guardian email.

#### Q. What municipality do I choose?

A. Choose the municipality that you live in or are closest to. Whichever one you pick will get your minutes counted to their total, so choose wisely!

#### Q. What if my municipality isn't listed?

A. You get to choose whichever one you want! (And let your municipality know to contact YARD to be included next year.)

### Q. Do I enter numbers for each family member in the weekly email?

A. You will need to complete the survey for each participating member of your family. (Do not combine your numbers with your child)

#### Q. How do I enter numbers in the survey?

A. List your numbers by MINUTES. For example, a one-hour hike should be counted at 60 minutes.

#### Reminder For Manchester Township Parks

As contained in Chapter 16, Part I of the Codified Ordinances of Manchester Township: Smoking including but not limited to cigarettes, cigars, illegal drugs, and vaping is prohibited in/on all Manchester Township park facilities at any time.

#### **Drones / RC Airplanes**

The use of motorized model airplanes and drones is restricted to designated areas and prohibited after **9:00 a.m.** Model rockets or the like are prohibited at all times. The restricted hours for the use of drones may be modified upon written request to the township manager or recreation director, and upon request of a written modification. The use of drones must comply with applicable federal aviation administration (FAA) regulations. The drone operator is responsible for compliance. **Section 16-111 Of the Codified Ordinances of Manchester Township**.





### **Rent-A-Kid Program**

**Call for a Rent-A-Kid in Your Area**. York County seniors interested in help with spring cleanup, mowing, yard work, electronic devices, or with other household chores are encouraged to arrange for a Rent-A-Kid.

The Rent-A-Kid program, sponsored by the York County Area Agency on Aging, is an intergenerational program that connects York County older adults and teenagers together.

For over 30 years, Kids have been helping and learning from older adults through the Rent-A-Kid program. It gives individual teenagers the chance to help York County senior citizens, 60 years or older, with indoor and outdoor household chores. The senior needs to be agreeable to a reimbursement of a minimum of \$5/hour, or a negotiated rate based on the job.



APPRISE is the State Health Insurance Assistance Program which provides counseling for people with Medicare in Pennsylvania. It was created by the Pennsylvania Department of Aging to help Pennsylvanians understand Medicare and their other health insurance benefits. Locally, this program is offered by the York County Area Agency on Aging.

APPRISE counselors are specially-trained volunteers who have direct access to state and federal Medicare resources. They are able to answer questions about Medicare, Medicaid, Medigap, Medicare Advantage plans and the prescription drug program. They can help you to:

- Understand your Medicare benefits by explaining which services are covered under Part A and B and your Medicare Summary Notice.
- Make informed choices about Medicare coverage options, including Medicare appeals process and assist with appeals paperwork.
- Select a Medigap insurance policy.
- Explain financial assistance programs that may be available to assist in paying for your Medicare premiums, deductibles and coinsurance, as well as your prescription drug needs.

- Explain the Medicare prescription drug benefit.
- Make presentations on Medicare to your organization.

# **Home Delivered Meals**

Monday - Friday / 11:00 am - 1:00 pm

The Home Delivered Meals Program is designed to provide a well-balanced daily meal to homebound older adults who are unable to prepare adequate meals for themselves and have no other means for assuring healthful nutrition.

On Monday, Wednesday and Friday, a hot meal is delivered to the older adult's home. Tuesday and Thursday meals are a cold bag lunch delivered with the previous day's hot meal.

Volunteers from the local senior center deliver the meals to the older adult's home. The Northeastern Senior Center is seeking volunteers for home delivered meals, please call **717-266-1400** if interested. Although this is a brief contact it does provide a check on the well being of the homebound individual. The home delivered meal service is not a cost shared service.

### **Eligibility For Home Delivered Meals**

To be eligible for Home Delivered Meals services an individual must be:

- A York County resident in a non-institutional setting.
- 60 years of age or older.
- Have a physical, mental or emotional disability, which prohibits the individual from leaving his/her residence on a regular basis and/or prevents them from preparing a nutritious meal.
- Living alone or with someone who also meets the above criteria

Monetary donations can be made to the York County Area Agency on Aging.

Care managers need to complete an in-home assessment to determine eligibility for Home Delivered Meals.



Agriculture Secretary Russell Redding shared some scary thoughts while reminding Pennsylvanians to be vigilant against the Spotted Lanternfly as the bugs begin laying eggs on flat surfaces to hatch in the spring.

"Every Spotted Lanternfly egg mass not scraped and destroyed now is up to 50 more of these invasive, destructive bugs we can expect to hatch next spring," said Redding. "We need every Pennsylvanian to hunt for egg masses this fall and winter and destroy them - or we're in for a scary spring."

Spotted Lanternfly egg masses are a light gray wax-like substance that take on the appearance of mud and include 30-50 eggs. Egg masses can be found on many flat surfaces including trees, rocks, and outside objects such as picnic tables, playground equipment, grills, and sidings of homes.

Property owners can scrape egg masses whenever encountered using a hard or rigid tool such as a credit card, putty knife, or a stick. Research has not yet confirmed whether egg masses can survive if scraped onto the ground, so it is best to scrape the egg masses in a downward motion into a container or bag with rubbing alcohol or hand sanitizer.

"Yard Waste" materials are defined as tree trimmings, shrubbery and any other organic landscape vegetation, excluding grass clippings.

### Materials should be packaged as follows:

- Place items in either Biodegradable Kraft bags or tied in easily handled bundles.
- Bundles should be no longer than four (4) feet in length.
- Bundles should not weigh more than 30 lbs each.
- Branches should not exceed 6 inches in diameter.

### The following items should not be placed out for Yard Waste Collection:


- Leaf Waste (Note: Manchester Township provides this service)
- Dirt or Stones
- Fruits and/or Vegetables
- Any material in a Plastic Bag

### **Storm Water Management Requirements**

Any building or zoning permit application that proposes any new impervious area must first satisfy the requirements of the storm water management ordinance.

#### Ultimately it is the property owners' responsibility to control runoff from their property.

This requirement is a mandate from the United States Environmental Protection Agency EPA, Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection DEP and the County of York. Manchester Township passed Ordinance 2012-05 in order to comply with the mandate. Failure to comply with the mandates would subject the township as a whole to penalties from either DEP and/or EPA.

Put simply, if property owner builds or places on their lot something that covers the ground so that rainwater cannot penetrate or that will not allow grass to grow something must be done to allow



#### the runoff to soak into the ground under a *normal* rain condition.

Anyone applying for a Building or Zoning Permit is required to address the storm water runoff from any new impervious area to be installed or placed on any lot.

You will need to know measurements of all structures, patios, sidewalks, swimming pools and paving, existing and proposed, on your lot in order obtain a storm water permit to meet these requirements **BEFORE** a building or zoning permit will be able to be issued.

#### **Leaves Don't Belong** In The Stormdrain

When it rains, it drains! Clean up leaves from the stormdrain at home, work or play.

#### The Drain Is Just For The Rain

It is illegal to dump anything into the storm sewers located along the streets. Do not dump used oil, gasoline, or grass clippings into the storm sewers.



### **Plan Ahead For Building Permits**

All construction, additions, placement of prebuilt structures (sheds, swimming pools, etc), paving, patios, fences, and decks require that a permit be obtained **BEFORE** any work can legally be started. This includes inflatable swimming pools over 18" if new or previously removed.

State law requires the township to adopt the Uniform Construction Code (UCC), better known as the "building code". The UCC allows a municipality up to 15 working days to review a

permit application for residential properties and either grant or reject the permit from the time a *completed application* is submitted to the municipality. A completed application includes a completely filled out application form, 3 copies of a site plan for the entire lot showing all **existing and proposed** improvements on the lot (including driveways, buildings, patios, decks, and sidewalks) with all dimensions and distances to property lines and 3

copies of all documentation related to the proposed improvements. Manchester Township strives to process the permits as quickly as possible although during busy times of the year it may take the full 15 working days. **NO WORK** can be started until you have a granted permit in hand and a placard placed in a location that can be seen from the street.

### **MS4** / Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System

### PLEASE DO NOT POLLUTE. Here are 10 things you can do at home:

- Use fertilizers sparingly and sweep up driveways and gutters.
- Never dump anything down storm drains or in streams.
- Vegetate bare spots in your yard.
- Compost your yard waste.
- Use least toxic pesticides, follow labels, and learn how to prevent pest problems.
- Direct downspouts away from

paved surfaces; consider a rain garden to capture runoff.

- Take your car to the car wash instead of washing it in the driveway.
- Check your car for leaks and recycle your motor oil.
- Pick up after your pet.
- Have your septic tank pumped and system inspected regularly.

#### **Sewer Backup Claims**

Under the Pennsylvania Governmental **Immunity** Statute. Manchester **Township** has limited responsibility for sewer and water backups. You should contact your homeowner's or commercial insurance agent to make sure you carry coverage for sewer and water backups under your homeowner's or commercial property policy. Some homeowner's policies do not include this coverage automatically. We recommend that you purchase this valuable coverage.

### **Tips from your Tax Collector**

It is tax time again and I would like to remind you to please write a contact phone number on your check. Unlisted phone numbers make it difficult to reach you if there is a question or problem with your check, resulting in missed rebates and late payments.

The rebate period for 2022 County/Township payments ends at midnight on April 18, 2022. The office window will be open from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm on Monday, April 18th for last minute payments. Any payments received in the night drop box on the morning of April 19th will be considered paid at rebate. Please do not ask me to break the law and accept payments after the deadline.

I receive many requests for changes to the homeowner information on the tax bills. Please note, for your protection, I am not able to change the name printed on your tax notice. The name on the tax bill comes from the York County deed database. If you would like to change your name due to marriage, etc. it must be changed at the Recorder of Deeds office. The only exception is I can remove a deceased spouse's name from the bill at the surviving spouse's request with a copy of the death certificate.

### **Tree Trimming Ordinance** #2014-01

Property owners are required to maintain clearance of trees and similar vegetation from the street cartway (curb to curb) to a height above the cartway of fourteen feet (14'). Upon notification of a violation, the property owner shall have **30 days** to correct the violation prior to being subject to penalties.

When considering your clean up and/or landscaping, please remember to keep your trees, hedges and bushes trimmed to no higher than three feet (3') within the clear sight triangle of any intersection of any street to improve safety and visibility.

#### No Parking Zones / **What Do The Signs** Mean?

Have you wondered what the double arrow signs, which are located under "No Parking" symbol signs, represent? The "No Parking" symbol signs and related double arrows are posted in accordance with PennDOT sign regulations which require the use of the double arrow signs to inform motorists that parking is restricted BETWEEN the posted "No Parking" symbol signs along the same side of the street on which the "No Parking" symbol signs are located. The double arrow signs DO NOT represent that parking is prohibited on both sides of the street.

#### **Smoke Testing Sewer Lines**

NOTICE - During April 4-29, 2022 the Public Works Department will be conducting smoke testing of the sanitary sewer lines in these following neighborhoods:

Smoke should not enter premises unless a leak is present. This smoke is non-toxic, non-corrosive, and will not leave a stain. If smoke enters a home, it will soon dissipate. Opening doors and windows will help. Any presence of smoke within the house should be reported to the township office at 717-764-4646. Avoid unnecessary exposure to the smoke. The smoke is relatively harmless, but all smoke is temporary and quickly disappears after exposure has ceased.



### Medication Take-Back Box Program

York County residents may anonymously deliver unused prescription and over-the-counter medications to secure Medication Return Boxes located in nearly all York County Police Department lobbies. There is no fee and the boxes are available year-round during lobby hours as listed, except on holidays. Residents interested in disposing of medication in a Medication Return Box location should remove their personal information from containers before disposal.

Place unused medications in your regular garbage – To minimize potential impacts to human health and the environment, take medication out of its original container and mix it with an undesirable substance, such as used coffee grounds or kitty litter. The medication will be less appealing to children and pets, and unrecognizable to people who may intentionally go through your trash. Place the mixture in a sealed bag, can or other container to prevent the medication from leaking. Before disposing of a prescription medicine container, destroy all identifying information to protect your identity and personal health information.

Free prescription medication delivery at the RRC – Make an appointment to deliver your unused prescription (no



over-the-counter) medications to the RRC at no charge. Prescription medications accepted must come from a single York County household (medications collected from multiple households cannot be accepted). Residents must call 717-845-1066 to make an appointment to deliver prescription medications to the RRC and are required to complete a brief registration form. At the RRC, residents will be escorted by an Authority representative to dispose of the medications. The disposal process takes approximately 20 minutes.

### How can you reduce the number of mosquitoes around your home and neighborhood?

Mosquitoes breed in standing water. Even a small bucket that has stagnant water in it for seven days can become home to up to 1,000 mosquitoes. Here are some easy tips to eliminate standing water:

- Dispose of tin cans, plastic containers, ceramic pots or similar water holding containers that have accumulated on your property. Do not overlook containers that have become overgrown by aquatic vegetation.
- Pay special attention to discarded tires that may have accumulated on your property.
- Drill holes in the bottom of recycling containers that are left out of doors. Drainage holes that are located on the container sides collect enough water for mosquitoes to breed in.
- Clean clogged roof gutters on an annual basis, particularly if the leaves from surrounding trees have a

- tendency to plug up the drains. Roof gutters are easily overlooked but can produce millions of mosquitoes each season.
- Turn over plastic wading pools when not in use. A wading pool becomes a mosquito producer if it is not used on a regular basis.
- Turn over wheelbarrows and do not allow water to stagnate in birdbaths. Both provide breeding habitat for domestic mosquitoes.
- Aerate ornamental pools or stock them with fish. Water gardens are fashionable but become major mosquito producers if they are allowed to stagnate. Clean and chlorinate swimming pools that are not being used. A swimming pool that is left untended by a family that goes on vacation for a month can produce enough mosquitoes to result in neighborhood-wide complaints. Be aware that mosquitoes may even breed in the water that collects on swimming pool covers.

#### **Nuisance Ordinance**

Per Ordinance #2007-01, don't place basketball hoops or other sporting equipment in roadway or in road right-of-way so play can occur in the street.

## The following are strictly prohibited and declared a nuisance:

 The throwing, pushing, blowing, placing or plowing of snow from private property into or onto a cartway of any street.

- Piling snow more than 3 feet high within the clear sight triangle of any intersection of any street.
- The placing of mulch, stone, dirt or building materials from private property into or onto a cartway of any street.
- Basketball hoops or other sports equipment within the street or road right-of-way.

- Detached trailers or storage units within the cartway.
- Dumping of any substances (oil, grass, etc.) into any storm sewer

Stone or brick mailboxes require a road occupancy permit before construction.

Any person who violates or fails to comply with these provisions may be fined up to \$600.00 per day.

### **Animal Control Ordinance** / #2009-05

In 2009 the Manchester Township Board of Supervisors adopted an animal control ordinance which addresses the keeping of domestic animals, as well as feral cat(s), and requires that anyone "keeping" a feral cat or cats, must see that they have been trapped, neutered and released (TNR) back into the wild.

The York County SPCA (717-764-6109) or Manchester Township's animal enforcement officer, Michelle Klugh (Klugh Animal Control) (717-916-1413), can provide assistance with feral cats.

Please be responsible in helping protect public health and safety by participating in a TNR program to control the feral cat population.

### Relax And Enjoy Your Vacation

The NYCRPD offers a free service for all residents when they are away from their homes on vacation. The NYCRPD will conduct periodic home checks to insure that your home is secure while you are away. Please complete the form on **nycrpd.org** and call 911 when you return home to cancel the home check.

### **Lets Have A Neighborhood Block Party**

How? A few simple steps will allow you to close your street for some fun. Your request should be submitted in writing, in a timely fashion, to the attention of the township manager.

#### Please include the following in your request:

- · The date and time of the block party, & whether there is a rain date.
- · A drawing showing the exact location and whether there is an alternate route which can be used by motorists while the road is closed.
- The signature of all property owners adjacent to the section of the affected roadway which you would like to close indicating they have no objection.

The Board of Supervisors must authorize any closures of township streets (this does not include state roadways).

Once these steps are followed, the Board will most likely grant your request. Upon granting such a request, the Board directs that the township public works department

drop off barricades which can be used to close the roadway during your block party. The township does request you keep all tables and chairs to one side, so in the event that there would be an emergency situation an ambulance, fire truck or police car, could easily gain access to the area by using the side of the roadway where there are no obstacles.
